Canon RF 200-500mm f/4L IS USM 'confirmed' for later this year



A Canon RF 200-500mm f/4L IS USM has been long rumoured and now the team over at *Canon Rumors* has managed to confirm its existence. We might even see it as soon as the end of this year. Canon already makes a similar EF version of this lens – the Canon EF 200-400mm f/4L IS USM Extender 1.4x. But the latest rumour suggests that to reduce the overall size and weight of the lens, the new RF version will forego the 1.4x teleconverter but will add an extra 100mm in focal length to compensate.

Wildlife and sports photographers needn't fear, however, as *Canon Rumors* also claims that a newly designed separate teleconverter extension is also coming soon, which will also work with the recently introduced Canon RF 100-300mm f/2.8L IS USM lens.

The Canon RF 200-500mm f/4L IS USM is expected to arrive by the fourth quarter of 2023 or at the beginning of 2024, and will come just before the Canon EOS R1 as photographers get ready for the Paris Olympics next summer. canon.co.uk
